Study design

Method:	CATI (Computer-assisted telephone interviews)
Countries:	Austria, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Russia, Switzerland, USA
Target group:	Country populations, males and females aged 15+*
Sample:	Representative sample of the population in each country, n=1,000 interviews*

* Russia: n=2,398 interviews ; USA: aged 18+

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


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Of the nine countries participating in the Confidence Study, the Swiss evaluate their country's current overall situation most positively, whereas Hungarians are least satisfied.


Current view - overall situation in the country

Situation over the next 12 months – overall situation in the country



When asked to assess their current personal situation, more than half of Austrians, Germans, Greeks, Swiss and Americans are positive.








Situation over the next 12 months – personal situation





















Germany is the only country where people are more optimistic regarding their personal future, compared to May 2008.




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Greeks and Italians evaluate issues related to the personal situation less confidently, compared to May 2008.






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In connection with the financial crisis, respondents in all countries are most concerned about their state pensions. (1/2)






