While hiding a watch's movement is more common, we love putting the mechanics on show as well. In the Hamilton Jazzmaster Open Heart, for instance, bold cutouts in the dial reveal the same H-10 movement beating away. Meanwhile, the Hamilton Khaki Aviation Converter is a chronograph for those who love to fly, with a bi-directional, rotating 'slide-rule' bezel that enables mathematical calculations in flight. The function can be applied to critical factors like airspeed, distance, fuel consumption, rate of climb or descent and flight time, and can also make various unit conversions including kilometers/nautical miles, pounds/kilograms, feet/meters, or even convert currency for those flying internationally.
